Welcome to the junior section of Barns Green Players. This pack is to let you have some useful notes to help you and contains a membership form to complete if you are not yet a member.

Also enclosed are some documents for you to pass to your parents/guardian which gives them the information they need. There are a couple of pages they need to sign and return to the Director at the next rehearsal.

Rehearsals - You will be given a rehearsal schedule by the Director. Please ensure that you get to rehearsal on time. If you are unable to attend due to illness then please let the Director know <u>before the start of the rehearsal</u>. (The Director will provide a contact number/email address on the rehearsal schedule.) Anyone missing rehearsals without a valid reason may not be able to continue in that production.

At the end of a rehearsal please do not leave the hall until someone has arrived to collect you and let one of the adult members know when you are leaving and with who. Unless we have been informed by your parents/guardians of other arrangements.

We also want to ensure that anyone auditioning and taking a part in a production is committed to doing this - if you are in any way unsure of whether you are able to commit yourself 100% then please discuss this with the Director.

Membership - You need to pay your membership (if you are not already a member) before the first rehearsal. Anyone not a member at the first rehearsal will not be able to be on stage and rehearse and will be asked to go home until they have paid their membership.

Membership can be done online through the Barns Green Players website. Once registered you will be sent an invoice which can be paid using paypal/credit card. You will then be made an active member.

Thank you for taking the time to read this and we hope it helps - if there is anything else you need to know then please ask any of the adult members. Enjoy the rehearsals and production and have fun!

Dear Parent/Guardian

The committee of Barns Green Players would like to make you aware/remind you of our policy regarding child protection; a copy of this policy is available for your inspection.

We would also like to inform/remind you of our responsibilities towards your children:

- Barns Green Players will be responsible for any children involved in productions (junior or adult) during rehearsals, performances, workshop sessions (these to include costume/scenery making sessions and clearing up after productions) or after show parties.
- All children will be supervised by at least one adult at all times. We will have a designated chaperone at each dress rehearsal/production. An updated list of these chaperones/child protection officers will also be available for your inspection. All those on the list will have been DBS checked and we will accept these issued by other authorities/societies. All chaperones are licensed by WSCC and have been considered by the committee to be suitably responsible and trustworthy with regard to the welfare of young people.

- We would like to remind you that Barns Green Players' responsibility extends only towards children who remain inside the village hall or within the rehearsal area (for some productions this area may be the barn or lakeside at Sumner's Ponds, Barns Green). Barns Green Players cannot be held responsible for the safety of any child leaving the hall or rehearsal area without adult supervision. Parents or guardians must be responsible for accompanying their children to and from the village hall or rehearsal area; they must also collect their children promptly after rehearsals, workshop sessions, performances or after show parties, or let us know of alternative arrangements. All children will need to be signed in/out of the hall for rehearsals, performances and any after show parties.
- We would also ask that you complete the attached sheet providing us with emergency contact information and any appropriate medical information we should be aware of for your child.

- Parents will be asked to give permission for their children to attend after show parties; please note that we will not condone under-age drinking, but again we cannot be responsible for any children drinking alcohol outside the village hall or rehearsal/party area.
- Parents also need to be aware of the limitations of our changing facilities in the back room of the village hall (known as the David Francis Room/Jubilee Hall). This is used for make-up, costume changing and storage of some scenery. It is also used to gain access to the sides of the stage during performances. We will do our utmost to ensure that the room is partitioned to provide adults and childrens changing areas, but this is a very busy area and it may not always be possible. However, they will always be overseen by the Chaperone. We therefore ask to you sign and return the slip overleaf as soon as possible.

If you have any other concerns regarding your child's involvement in our society please speak to one of the committee officers. We also ask you to sign the attached sheet concerning the taking of photos or images.
